All seniors must meet the following criteria in order to have Prom and Grad Nite contracts approved:

- An overall 2.0 GPA on 3rd quarter progress grades /or last semester
- Have a "C-" or better on senior classes or current 2nd semester core courses
- Good attendance (must have no more than 5 period truanancies and/or 11 period tardies)

COMMENCEMENT:

Wednesday, June 6th - Stadium @7pm

- Seniors are to report to the Main Gym at 5:45 p.m.
- Tables will be against the wall in alphabetical order. Find your table and pick up the white and blue cards with your name on them.
- If you wish to have your name read with a strong Spanish accent, write an "S" in the corner of the blue card. That is the card you will give the speaker when you enter the stadium for graduation.
- You will line up outside the stadium. Posters indicating line numbers will be posted against the fence. Line assignments will be posted on the Guidance Office windows by June 4th.
- You will keep the white card until after the ceremony. At that time, you will return to the Gym and at the same table, to pick up your diploma after giving the white card to the teacher at your table.
- Coats and purses may be checked in at the cafeteria doors opposite the gym at Graduation.
- **No leis, corsages, etc. may be worn on caps or gowns. DO NOT DECORATE YOUR CAP! IT WILL BE REMOVED AND EXCHANGED FOR A NEW ONE. NO BEDAZZLED TASSELS ARE TO BE WORN.**
- **No flowers, balloons, beach balls, signs, banners, blow horns etc. may be taken into the stadium for the graduation ceremony.**
- **Students/Guests making inappropriate loud noises or gestures will be asked to leave the graduation ceremony.**
- **NO ADMISSION INTO STADIUM AND VISITOR SIDE AFTER 7:30 P.M.**

It is important that during graduation you respect the rights of your fellow Seniors and their families. If any student disrupts the graduation ceremony we will remove that student from the stadium. Let's show your teachers, families and peers what a great class 2018 is. We want this to be the best graduation this school has ever experienced.

- \$120.00 for grad/\$125.00 for guest includes transportation, food buffet, admission and free season pass (June-Dec) to Magic Mountain.
- Tickets go on sale, Monday, April 2, in the Activities Office. We will sell every day until April 30th or when tickets are sold out. You must have completed contract to purchase ticket. Buses will depart at 7:00 p.m. on the south service road between the campus and City Hall. Park cars in the East Parking lot of school. Buses will return at approximately 5:00 a.m. on Friday.
- Reminder there is a dress code and drug/alcohol regulations at Magic Mountain. Go to www.sixflags.com/magicmountain/special-events/gradnite for additional information.

ACTIVITIES OFFICE/PAYMENT INFO-

- Students are not to come to Activities Office during class time to conduct business. The office will be open before school, during lunch, and after school until 3:30 p.m. Cashier's office closes at 1PM on minimum days.
- Sorry, no personal checks. We accept cash, cashier's checks and money orders or VISA and MasterCard with matching photo ID.
- CURRENT SCHOOL ID will be required for identification when you purchase tickets for all year-end senior activities.
- If you participate in Ditch Day or a Senior Prank, you may be excluded from participating in the graduation ceremonies or be excluded from Grad Nite
- It is important that during graduation you respect the rights of your fellow Seniors and their families. If any student disrupts the graduation ceremony we will remove that student from the stadium.

REMINDERS FROM YOUR COUNSELORS:

- You must not be absent: Excessive tardies and trancies may result in loss of senior activity privileges!
